

# Nad-e-Ali<sup>asws</sup>

## (As Per Traditions of Masomeen<sup>asws</sup>)<sup>1</sup>

وعن عكرمة، عن علي عليه السلام قال قال لي النبي صلى الله عليه وآله يوم احد: أما تسمع مديحك في السماء؟ إن ملكا اسمه رضوان ينادي: لا سيف إلا ذو الفقار، ولا فتى إلا علي.  
قال: ويقال: إن النبي صلى الله عليه وآله نودي في هذا اليوم:

ناد عليا مظهر العجائب  
تجده عوناً لك في النوائب  
كل هم و غم سينجلي  
بولايته يا علي يا علي

It has been narrated by Ikrima that he heard Imam Ali<sup>asws</sup> say that the Holy Prophet<sup>saww</sup> informed him<sup>asws</sup>: 'On the day of Ohad (Battle): 'I<sup>saww</sup> heard your<sup>asws</sup> praise from the sky, as Angel Rizwaan<sup>as</sup> was descending and reciting: 'There is no sword like Zulfaqqar and there is no warrior like Ali<sup>asws</sup>. At that instance, I<sup>saww</sup> was asked to seek help by reciting:

**Call Ali<sup>asws</sup> who manifests wonders  
You will find him the most helpful in all calamities  
All grief and anxiety will disappear  
Under your<sup>asws</sup> Wilait<sup>2</sup> Ya Ali<sup>asws</sup>, Ya Ali<sup>asws</sup>, Ya Ali<sup>asws</sup>.**
