A: You need to add a call to the left method of MKMapView with the coordinates of the annotation that you want to position on the left. For example: CLLocationCoordinate2D annotationCoordinates = [newLocation coordinate]; [[self.mapView leftAnnotation] setCoordinate:annotationCoordinates]; A: Here's a code example for setting the annotation to the left of the map: MKMapView \*mapView = (MKMapView \*)[self.view viewWithTag:1]; CLLocationCoordinate2D annotationCoordinates =... // move your annotation up to the middle of the map so it's somewhat visible CLLocationCoordinate2D originalCoordinates = [[location objectAtIndex:0] coordinate]; CLLocationCoordinate2D newCoordinates = [newLocation coordinate]; newCoordinates.longitude = (double)originalCoordinates.longitude; newCoordinates.latitude = (double)originalCoordinates.latitude; // position your annotation's coordinate annotationCoordinates.latitude = (double)newCoordinates.latitude; annotationCoordinates.longitude = (double)newCoordinates.longitude; [mapView setCenterCoordinate:annotationCoordinates]; Make sure you have set the map view's delegate property to self, and add a method called -(void)mapView:(MKMapView \*)mapView didAddAnnotationViews:(NSArray \*)views to know when annotations are added/removed from the map.
